

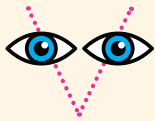

Drug Recognition Experts use the following indicators to determine Cannabis* impairment:



LACK OF CONVERGENCE:
Present



PUPIL SIZE:
Dilated; Possibly normal



OVERDOSE SIGNS

- Excessive vomiting
- Fatigue
- Acute anxiety attacks
- Paranoia
- Possible psychosis



PULSE RATE: Up



BLOOD PRESSURE: Up

16 GENERAL INDICATORS



- Altered time/distance perception
- Alteration in thought formation
- Body tremors
- Bloodshot eyes
- Disorientation
- Drowsiness
- Eyelid tremors
- Euphoria
- Impaired memory
- Increased appetite
- Lack of concentration
- Mood changes
- Odor of marijuana
- Rebound dilation
- Relaxed inhibitions
- Sedation
